Our Creative Learning team are currently looking for freelancers with a Level 3 Forest School certificate to support our work starting from next financial year, 2026/27.

We are especially welcoming applicants from backgrounds representing the diverse communities of Birmingham we work with.

The role is paid an agreed hourly or daily rate to help our existing services deliver more activity and identify new opportunities.

#### **Areas of responsibility and key tasks:**

- To plan, prepare and deliver a range of sessions at different sites across Birmingham, and especially during school holidays, supporting children and families connect with and increase their sense of appreciation of the natural world.
- To supervise and support children with varying needs while delivering sessions.
- To create and maintain an engaging, fun and supportive environment, demonstrating flexibility in planning and running sessions in response to varying/changing needs of children.
- To participate in training and other learning activities/meetings as required.
- To administer basic first aid as the need arises.
- To comply with ecobirmingham policies, procedures and strategic aims.
